Thank you very much for requesting an application pack for the 2010 Maldon Mud Race.

The event is going from strength to strength with us now registered as a Charity in our own right, and very grateful thanks must be given to the Lions & Rotary Clubs of Maldon for their support over the past 8 years.

The December 2009 event saw the largest field of competitors ever, with approximately 250 people taking part, however, it has been very disappointing to report that 100 of those people (*Yes ! that's over 40%*) did not raise one penny in sponsorship, which is truly against the spirit of the Maldon Mud Race, and which in turn has been reflected in the donations that we are able to make to the nominated charities, never the less, to date we have still been able to donate the sum of £4,000.00 each to; **Essex Air Ambulance, Little Havens Children's Hospice, 21st Century Youth, and The Soldiers Charity (formerly The Army Benevolent Fund) £3000.00 to Burnham on Crouch RNLI**, plus other smaller donations, and donations made by the competitors directly to the charities of their choice.

We are therefore making it a condition of entry for the 2010 event, which will now take place on **Monday 25th April 2011 at 1.00pm**, that competitors will sign up to raise a minimum of £50.00 in sponsorship (Teams £50 per member of each team).

JUST GIVING We are pleased to announce that for the 2010 event, all of the sponsorship will be conducted through the 'Just-Giving' web site, this was requested by many competitors last year....and we have listened.

The Maldon Mud Race

Rules of Entry

The Maldon Mud Race will now be held at the Maldon Promenade Park commencing at 1.00pm on Monday 25th April 2011

1. A non returnable Entry Fee of £40.00. Will be paid by each person entering the race.
2. Each competitor will receive a Maldon Mud Race T shirt before the race takes place, they will also receive a medal for completing the course and a DVD of the event. These will be sent as soon as the official DVD is received by The Maldon Mud Race committee.
3. All competitors will agree to raise a minimum of £50.00. Sponsorship by 11th April 2011. The Maldon Mud Race committee has the right to cancel the entry if the £50.00 is not raised by this date.
4. All sponsorship money will be raised through the '[Just Giving](#)' website.
5. All competitors will be advised of how to arrange their own sponsorship page on Just Giving once the entry fee of £40.00. Has been received.
6. Competitors entering in teams will be expected to raise a minimum sponsorship of £200. 00. (Team of 4 people) and a minimum of £300. 00. (For a team of 6 people.) by 11th April 2011. The Maldon Mud Race Committee has the right to cancel any entry if this sponsorship is not raised by the set date.
7. The prize for the highest amount of sponsorship money raised will go to the competitor who has raised the most sponsorship through their Just Giving web page by 25th June 2011.
8. The total number of competitors will be restricted to 250.
9. Teams must consist of four or six members, only the first 4-team members to complete the course will qualify for points and prizes. Points will be awarded according to your finishing position.
10. Scoring will be based on the first four members of a team's finishing position. The points will be awarded inverse of their finishing positions, therefore the lowest aggregated team score will win.
11. All competitors must sign -in at least one hour before the start of the event.
12. **All competitors must wear footwear which must be taped to their feet.**
13. No competitors under the age of 18 years will be allowed to take part in the event (The decision of the registered Marshall(s) will prevail.)
14. All competitors enter at their own risk and the organisers of The Maldon Mud race do not accept liability for loss or injury.

15. All competitors must complete the health and fitness declaration which must be returned to the organizing committee with the entry form. The organizing committee reserves the right to refuse the entry. Failure to provide evidence will result in the entry being declined.

16. Gift aid will be collected through Just Giving, Each competitor can request that 50% of their sponsorship be donated to a registered charity of their choice. This will be done directly by The Maldon Mud Race once all sponsorship money has been received. A letter of confirmation will be sent to all competitors advising them that The Maldon Mud Race have sent the 50% donation to the charity requested.

In the event of the maximum number of competitors not being reached on the day, late entries will be accepted at the registration desk up to one hour before the event commences on payment of a £50.00. Entry fee and completion of the entry form.

All competitors are strongly advised to ensure their anti-tetanus injections are up to date.

The decision of the organizing committee in all matters appertaining to the race shall be final and binding in all matters.
